Dear Requester,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

All correspondence between the Department and DAA about the development of a dedicated immigration unit at Dublin Airport, between February 2017 and November 2017.

I refer also to our communication of 13/14 November on the subject and the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 24 November.

I have identified no records that fall within the scope of your request. In that light I am refusing your request on administrative grounds under section 15(1)(a)... the record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken.

## Right of Appeal

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification. However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Department.
