I refer to the request of 8 November which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

All communications sent and received both within the Department and with outside agencies relating to delays in the appointment of a US Ambassador to Ireland. I wish to cover the timeframe: 01/01/17 to present day.

No records have been identified that fall within the scope of your request. The appointment of Ambassadors by the United States is an internal process of that country. While the Government looks forward to receiving a new Ambassador when one is appointed, it would be inappropriate to comment on the appointment process in another country.
