Dear Ms. Simpson,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

• All invoices in relation to spending on make-up, cosmetics and hair styling (to include both products and services) by the Department in 2019.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 2 December.

Having requested a search of the Department's electronic and financial records, no records exist in relation to the above request. Therefore your request falls for refusal under Section 15(1)(a) of the FOI Act, that is, " the record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken"
