I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

I should like to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for the letter of credentials presented by the representative of Ireland in Ramallah, Jonathan Conlon.

Section 42 of the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2014 sets out the exclusion of certain records from the scope of FOI. Under Section 42 (h) this includes records relating to the President of Ireland.

The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Department.
