Dear Requester,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

“The names of Civil Society Organisations located in Israel and Palestine in receipt of €100,000 or less from Irish Aid, in 2017. This information was publicly available in Irish Aid’s Annual report in 2015 and 2016 but was not published in 2017.”

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 26 November 2018.


