A breakdown of the amount spent by the Dept on named chocolates to date in 2014 and for the entire of 2013.

The number of boxes of chocolate purchased to date in 2014 and in 2013.

3/ An update on efforts by the Dept of Foreign Affairs on selling its wine collection.

Can you provide invoices of any wine sales by the Dept in 2014.

Internal reports on the progress of the wine sales.

4/The amount spent by the Dept at Dublin's Michelin star restaurants in 2013 and to date in 2014-Patrick Guilbaud, Chapter One, Thorntons and Bon Appetit and the amount spend at each restaurant in 2013 and to date in 2014.
