Paul O'Hanrahan leads the award-winning Irish repertory theatre company, Balloonatics, who have re-enacted Joyce's Ulysses in its home city for almost 30 years.

Cahal Stephens performs as part of the equally successful Here Come Everybody Players, a group based in Boston who have adapted and performed Joyce for stage across the United States and Ireland.
