The concept note will serve as a basis for assessment and possible further discussion with the Embassy, and should answer the following questions:

- Description of proposed approach
- Project duration and tentative time-table for execution (starting in second quarter of 2021)
- How will resources, human resources, networks, knowledge be mobilized?
- Are there other stakeholders that the project will engage to achieve the objective?
- Highlight any innovation the project is introducing?

• Briefly describe the plan to sustain/expand/utilize the project outcome, beyond the period of the Embassy's funding
